Finance Office

From the start of term 3 2022 the finance office will be open to serve students only. Parents/carers are advised to make payment using the Bpoint link on their invoice or statement, the QKR app, or by emailing their request to <u>finance@ipswichshs.eq.edu.au</u>.

For any queries that need to be answered in person, parents/carers are to enter through the front reception office.

Monthly Statements

Debtor Statements are sent monthly to advise of any amounts owing or credits on your students account.

If you do not receive a statement this is an indication that your account is paid in full.

If you see a **negative amount** on your Debtor Statement, this is a credit on your account. These funds can be used to offset current or future invoices. If you notice a negative amount that you would like to use, please contact the finance office by email to <u>finance@ipswichshs.eq.edu.au</u> so they can process this for you.

How to use credits to pay an invoice for fees, an excursion, or for uniforms

- Reply to the email you received with the invoice
- Send an email request to finance@ipswichshs.eq.edu.au
- Write a request note in your child's diary
- Email the uniform shop on <u>uniform@ipswichshs.eq.edu.au</u> with your request, advising of your available credit balance
